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Bulk Waste Guidelines

Bulk waste includes household items such as couches, chairs, mattresses, tables, appliances, carpets, padding, fencing and metal poles. It also includes yard waste such as tree trimmings, branches, palm fronds and lumber. Do not place your carts and/or bulk items near mailboxes, fences or cars. To ensure bulk waste pickup, follow these guidelines:

- Collection takes place once a month. See bulk collection schedule.
- Place bulk waste items curbside in a neat and orderly manner before 7 AM on your scheduled collection day. Collection will take place between 7 AM and 7 PM.
- Tree trimmings, branches and palm fronds should be arranged in a neat and orderly manner curbside.
- Residents of the BMSD may contact their hauler, Coastal Waste and Recycling, at 954-947-4000 for additional services. The resident is responsible for requesting a quote if additional collection services are needed.

Haulers will not pick up the following unacceptable items:

- Batteries, oil, paints, insecticides, chemicals and other hazardous waste.
- Materials/waste from commercial operations, including construction debris, lawn/yard services.
- Automotive parts including automotive bodies, engines, transmissions, large truck tires, mounted automobile tires, as well as marine parts.



Garbage and Recycling Carts Guidelines

- Garbage and recycling carts should be placed out only on the scheduled collection days for your Service Area.
- Carts should be placed curbside before 7 AM but no more than 24 hours prior to collection.
- Carts will not be collected after crews have finished collecting on your street.
- Do not place your carts near mailboxes, fences or cars.
- Property owners are responsible for tenant compliance with all applicable County Codes.
- Carts are the property of Broward County; it is a violation to remove them from assigned address.



Recycle These Items

All recyclable items can be placed together in the blue cart with the recycling symbol. For more information on your garbage and recycling services, call 954-847-BMSD (2673) or visit Broward.org/recycling.

Recycle only the items pictured below in the blue recycling cart provided to you. Just place all of the following recyclable materials together in your blue cart (do not bag materials before placing in your cart).

Large or oversized cardboard boxes should be broken down or cut into pieces and placed inside the blue recycling cart.

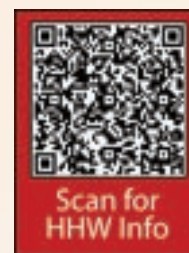

**Maximum of 5 tires accepted per load with rims less than 25 inches in diameter.*

NOTE: Containers filled with hazardous fluids may not exceed five gallons; limit 25 gallons per visit.

ACCEPTABLE ELECTRONICS:

Answering machines, computer cables, cell phones, computers (including laptops), copiers, DVD and VCR players, fax machines, flash and hard drives, keyboards/mice, monitors, pagers, print cartridges, printers, radios, routers, satellite/cable boxes, scanners, speakers/stereos, telephones, televisions and wires

ACCEPTABLE BULK AND YARD WASTE:

Yard waste, home furniture and furnishings, appliances and woody items (fencing and lumber) will be accepted. HHW and used electronics recycling items are accepted but must be kept separate from bulk trash.

ITEMS THAT ARE NOT ACCEPTED:

Business-and government-generated waste, explosives, medical waste and bio-hazardous waste. Scan QR code above for more information.

Note: If you wish to make a drop-off, please bring proof of residency (photo ID and a document that shows your official address such as a tax bill, TRIM notice, voter registration, utility bill, or other official government-issued document).

DISPOSAL GUIDELINES FOR UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- **Chemical Disposal for Businesses and Government Agencies**
Small businesses (including home-based), government agencies and non-profits that generate hazardous waste and/or electronics should not bring waste to any Broward County facility. For information, please call 954-847-2673 or 954-357-8850.
- **Compact Fluorescent Lamps (CFLs)**
If you accidentally break a fluorescent bulb or tube, safely dispose of it by following EPA guidelines for Cleanup and Disposal of broken CFLs. Scan QR code above for more information.
- **Medication Disposal**
Do not dispose of prescription medications by flushing them down a toilet or drain, as this will contaminate our water system. For information about local medication disposal, call 954-831-8902 or visit the Broward Sheriff's Office website.
- **Sharps (Needle) Disposal**
Sharps are considered bio-hazardous waste and should never be thrown directly into the trash. For information about their safe disposal and a list of sites accepting sharps, contact Florida Health Department at 850-245-4277.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

BE BATTERY SMART:

All Batteries are potentially dangerous.

1. ALWAYS follow the manufacturer's instructions included with the battery or device.
2. RECYCLE options are available. You may bring them to one of our Residential Drop-Off Centers.
3. DO NOT place rechargeable batteries in your household garbage or recycling cart.

Rechargeable Batteries

Cell phones, remote control toys, laptops and power tools are just a few household items that use rechargeable batteries, which contain cadmium or lithium, both of which are considered toxic heavy metals. **It is illegal to dispose of rechargeable batteries in regular trash.**

ATTENTION BMSD RESIDENTS

As part of the "Paint It Broward" initiative through the County's Household Hazardous Waste program each household, in the Broward Municipal Services District, may receive up to 20 gallons of free recycled exterior latex paint. Paint is distributed in five-gallon containers and residents are advised to get enough paint to complete a project. Batch colors will vary and finding an exact match at a later date is not likely.

WHO DO I CONTACT IF GARBAGE, BULK WASTE, OR RECYCLING IS NOT PICKED UP?

Residents of BMSD may report missed collection or complaints by submitting a service request or contact customer service at 954-847-BMSD or 311.

WHAT TYPE OF WASTE IS NOT ACCEPTED AT THE CURB?

Hazardous waste, automotive, marine parts and materials/ waste from commercial operations, including construction debris, lawn/yard services.

WHO DO I CONTACT FOR ADDITIONAL BULK COLLECTION SERVICES?

Residents of the BMSD may contact Coastal Waste and Recycling at 954-947-4000 for additional services. The resident is responsible for the cost associated with the additional collection services.

Call the paint hotline at 954-357-9678 to pre-order up to 20 gallons of recycled exterior paint and arrange details for pickup.*

**Recycled paint is available to BMSD residents only with proof of residency. You must show proof of address as a resident of BMSD in the form of a driver's license, current Broward County utility bill, current TRIM notice or current tax bill.*

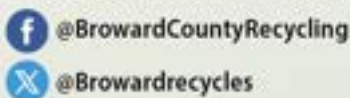
