1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE FOR FISCAL YEAR
3 2026-2027 FOR THE BROWARD MUNICIPAL SERVICES DISTRICT COMPRISING
4 THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF BROWARD COUNTY; AND PROVIDING FOR
5 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

7 WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Section 200.065(2), Florida Statutes,
8 the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), on
9 September 10, 2026, held a public hearing on the tentative budget and proposed millage
10 rate for the Broward Municipal Services District comprising the unincorporated areas of
11 Broward County; and

12 WHEREAS, the Board desires to adopt a proposed millage rate for Fiscal Year
13 2026-2027 for the Broward Municipal Services District comprising the unincorporated
14 areas of Broward County, NOW, THEREFORE,

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
16 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

17 Section 1. The Board hereby adopts a proposed millage rate of 2.3353 for the
18 Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2026, and ending September 30, 2027. The proposed
19 millage rate constitutes an 8.86 percent increase in property taxes as compared to a
20 rolled-back rate of 2.1453.
