RESOLUTION NO. 2026-564

1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR
3 2026-2027 FOR THE BROWARD MUNICIPAL SERVICES DISTRICT COMPRISING
4 THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF BROWARD COUNTY; AND PROVIDING FOR
5 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

7 WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Sections 129.03 and 200.065(2),
8 Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida
9 ("Board"), held a public hearing on September 10, 2026, on the tentative budget and
10 proposed millage rate for the Broward Municipal Services District comprising the
11 unincorporated areas of Broward County for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2026,
12 and ending September 30, 2027; and

13 WHEREAS, the Board has complied with all requirements of said sections and
14 desires to adopt its tentative budget, NOW, THEREFORE,

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
16 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

17 Section 1. The Board hereby adopts a tentative budget for the
18 Broward Municipal Services District comprising the unincorporated areas of Broward
19 County for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2026, and ending September 30, 2027,
20 as shown on the Summary of Budgets attached to this Resolution as Schedule A and
21 Schedule B.

Section 2. This Resolution and a copy of the tentative budget, as adopted, shall be filed with the Broward County Finance and Administrative Services Department, Records, Taxes, and Treasury Division.

Section 3. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
