

## COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT REQUIREMENTS

### For Temporary Childcare Assistance:

Individual(s) must be working a minimum of 20 hours per week or attend school full time.

### For Employment Assistance:

Individuals must be highly motivated and willing to accept reasonable job offers, respond to job leads and register with EmployFlorida (CareerSource Broward).

### For Tuition Assistance:

Individual(s) must be enrolled in an accredited institution and not eligible for Federal Aid or other financial assistance.
