RESOLUTION NO. 2026-570

1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF
3 GARBAGE AND TRASH PURSUANT TO SECTION 30-458(a) OF THE BROWARD
4 COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES; ESTABLISHING AND IMPOSING THE ANNUAL
5 SPECIAL ASSESSMENT RATES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN
6 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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8 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida
9 ("Board"), desires to levy special assessments for the purpose of collection and disposal
10 of garbage and trash within the Broward Municipal Services District comprised of the
11 unincorporated area of Broward County in accordance with Section 30-458(a) of the
12 Broward County Code of Ordinances ("Code") for the Fiscal Year beginning
13 October 1, 2026, and ending September 30, 2027, NOW, THEREFORE,

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
15 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

16 Section 1. Authority.

17 This Resolution is adopted pursuant to the provisions of Section 30-458 of the
18 Code, Section 125.01(1)(q), Florida Statutes, the Broward County Charter, and other
19 applicable provisions of law.

Section 2. Establishment and Imposition of Special Assessments.

In order to provide for the collection and disposal of garbage and trash within the Broward Municipal Services District, there shall be an annual special assessment of Three Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$390) on each single-family residential unit and each multifamily (nine units or less) residential unit within the district for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2026, and ending September 30, 2027.

Section 3. Assessment and Benefit.

(a) It is hereby ascertained, determined, and declared that each parcel of assessed property located within the Broward Municipal Services District will be benefited by the County's provision of garbage and trash services in an amount not less than the special assessment imposed against such parcel.

(b) It is hereby ascertained, determined, and declared that the method of determining the assessment is a fair and reasonable method of apportioning the costs of garbage and trash collection and disposal among the parcels located within the district.

Section 4. Notice and Public Hearing.

(a) Notice of the proposed Fiscal Year 2026-2027 special assessment rates for garbage and trash collection and disposal within the unincorporated area of Broward County has been provided to the owners of each affected parcel by use of the Notice of Proposed Property Taxes (TRIM notice) and mailed by first-class mail.

(b) The rates are hereby established after publication of the notice of the public hearing, such public hearing having been held on September 10, 2026, at 5:01 p.m. at Broward County Governmental Center East, Room 422, 115 South Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301, at which time the Board received and considered any

comments from the public and affected property owners relative to imposing such assessments.

Section 5. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
