RESOLUTION NO. 2026-561

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE FOR GENERAL BROWARD COUNTY PURPOSES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Section 200.065(2), Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), held a public hearing on September 10, 2026, on the tentative budget and proposed millage rate for general Broward County ("County") purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to adopt a proposed millage rate for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2026, and ending September 30, 2027, for general County purposes, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby adopts a proposed millage rate of 5.6658 for general County purposes for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2026, and ending September 30, 2027. The proposed millage rate constitutes a percentage increase in property taxes of 5.03 percent as compared to a rolled-back rate of 5.3946.

Section 2. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this

Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
