RESOLUTION NO. 2026-576

1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR THE USES AND
3 PURPOSES OF WATER CONTROL DISTRICT NO. 4 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027;
4 AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

6 WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Sections 129.03 and 200.065(2),
7 Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida
8 ("Board"), held a public hearing on September 10, 2026, on the tentative budget and
9 proposed millage rates for Water Control District No. 4 including Subdistricts 4A, 4B, and
10 4C for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2026, and ending September 30, 2027; and

11 WHEREAS, the Board has complied with all requirements of said sections and
12 desires to adopt its tentative budget for Water Control District No. 4 including
13 Subdistricts 4A, 4B, and 4C, NOW, THEREFORE,

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
15 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

16 Section 1. The Board hereby adopts a tentative budget for the uses and
17 purposes of Water Control District No. 4 including Subdistricts 4A, 4B, and 4C for the
18 Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2026, and ending September 30, 2027, as shown on
19 the Summary of Budgets attached to this Resolution as Schedule A and Schedule B.

Section 2. This Resolution and a copy of the tentative budget, as adopted, shall be filed with the Broward County Finance and Administrative Services Department, Records, Taxes, and Treasury Division.

Section 3. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
