Greetings, Counsel. I am in receipt of the complaint and motion to dismiss in this cause. I would like to schedule a status conference by Zoom in the near future. I am tentatively setting this matter for Friday, March 13, at 3 pm.

I realize this is short notice so, if that date and time is a problem for either side, please let me know and we will reschedule. I am available most days in the mid-afternoon, so, if the 13th won't work for your schedule, please suggest some other dates (either before or after the 13th) for a conference at about 3 pm. And, if either side offers alternative dates, I would appreciate it if the other side would respond by indicating availability or non-availability for those dates.

Please be prepared to discuss at the status conference a presumptive date for a final hearing, should the motion to dismiss be denied or the

case otherwise not resolved. My desire to establish such a date is simply to provide us with a framework to proceed and should not be viewed as expressing any thoughts about the motion to dismiss as I have not read it yet and will not do so until a response is filed or an indication is given that one will not be filed.
