RESOLUTION NO. 2026-575

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING PROPOSED MILLAGE RATES FOR WATER CONTROL DISTRICT NO. 4 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), held a public hearing on September 10, 2026, on the tentative budget and proposed millage rates for Water Control District No. 4 including Subdistricts 4A, 4B, and 4C for Fiscal Year 2026-2027; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to adopt proposed millage rates for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2026, and ending September 30, 2027, for Water Control District No. 4 including Subdistricts 4A, 4B, and 4C, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby adopts the following proposed millage rates for Water Control District No. 4 including Subdistricts 4A, 4B, and 4C for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2026, and ending September 30, 2027:

Subdistrict 4A	0.0115
Subdistrict 4B	0.0312
Subdistrict 4C	0.1200

Section 2. The proposed millage rates constitute a 0.00 percent increase in property taxes in Subdistrict 4A as compared to a rolled-back rate of 0.0115; a 0.00 percent increase in property taxes in Subdistrict 4B as compared to a rolled-back rate of 0.0312; and a 0.00 percent increase in property taxes in Subdistrict 4C as compared to a rolled-back rate of 0.1200.

Section 3. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
